

OTHER LEAF COLLECTION OPTIONS

Curbside Paper Leaf Bags:

- Residents can set out paper leaf bags for curbside collection on the day of their normal refuse/recycling collection.
- Curbside collection of paper leaf bags will continue now through the end of the second week in January.
- Leaves in barrels, plastic bags or cardboard containers will **NOT** be collected.
- No rubbish is to be mixed in with leaves.
- Paper bags are available for sale at the Transfer Station, 311 Olcott St.:
 - 30 gallon bags may be purchased in bundles of 5 for \$2.00
 - 45 gallon bags may be purchased in bundles of 5 for \$3.00 (while supplies last)
- Due to Covid-19, bags will not be for sale at other Town offices.
- Paper leaf bags purchased from retail stores are also acceptable.

Drop Off Sites:

- Residents may drop off loose or paper bagged leaves at the Transfer Station year-round during regular hours.
- ONLY** residents may drop off loose or paper bagged leaves at the parking lot at 263 Olcott Street from October 15th to December 31st when the Transfer Station is closed. (No brush or plastic bags, please. No contractors are allowed to use this drop site.)

DO

Sidewalk with grass divider:
Place between sidewalk and street



Sidewalk next to the street: Place on the back of sidewalk where possible. Keep 3 ft clear for pedestrians.



No Sidewalk: No more than 8 ft. from the street, behind the back of curb

Do Not place leaves in the street

Do Not place limbs with leaves

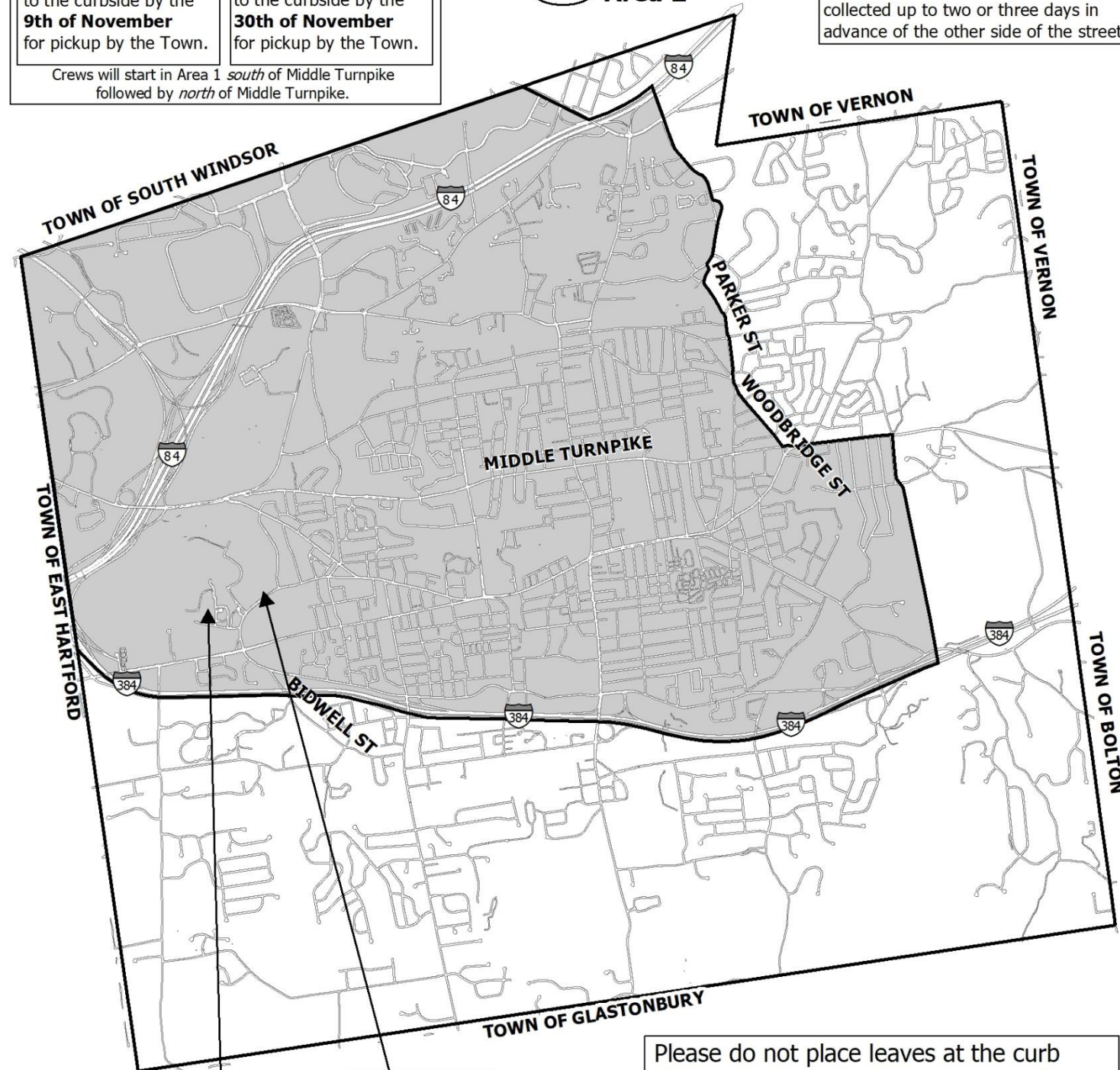

As part of the continuing effort to improve efficiency and maintain the safest operation possible, leaves on one side of a street will occasionally be collected up to two or three days in advance of the other side of the street.

All leaves must be raked to the curbside by the **9th of November** for pickup by the Town.

All leaves must be raked to the curbside by the **30th of November** for pickup by the Town.

Crews will start in Area 1 *south* of Middle Turnpike followed by *north* of Middle Turnpike.

263 OLCOTT ST. PARKING LOT LEAF DROP OFF SITE (after 3:15 p.m.)

Please do not place leaves at the curb after your street has been vacuumed. Crews will not be returning for a second collection. It's a violation of town codes to block sidewalks and streets with leaves.

- Each street will be scheduled for **ONE** curbside vacuum collection.
- Rake leaves to the edge of your property for collection. **Do not block sidewalk or place in road.**
- Keep storm drains free of leaves.
- Help us by keeping leaf piles free of brush, refuse, rocks and other foreign debris.
- Piles of leaves that are contaminated with debris damage the equipment and will **NOT** be collected.
- Leaves may be picked up on one side of a street two or three days in advance of the other side.
- Do not let children play in leaf piles raked to curb.
- If the curbside is blocked by parked cars, crews will not return.
- Collection schedule is subject to change due to weather, volume of leaves to be collected or other unforeseen circumstances. Because of this, we cannot determine when the crew will be at a specific location. Your understanding is appreciated.
- Manchester recycles over 35,000 cubic yards of leaves annually.
